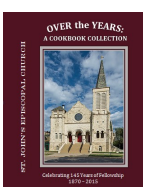
PARISH NEWS & NOTES

In order to continue to provide quality music for our 10:30 service, we are embarking on a new program which we're calling "**Adopt a Singer.**" You may be asking why we are doing this. Because of budget cuts we all are having to tighten our belts in most areas. The money allotted to the choir will only get us through the first half of 2016. In order for us to keep our paid singers we need to come up with an additional \$3000. As you know, our choir is not large - we average ten or eleven people each week. If we would lose our paid singers, we would be in serious trouble.

This is how the "Adopt a Singer" program works. You can adopt a singer for \$50 a Sunday. If you want to adopt someone for two Sundays it would cost \$100. You can adopt any singer in the choir for as many Sundays as you wish. If we would happen to go beyond our goal of \$3000, the extra money could be used for tuning the piano, paying instrumentalists when we need them, or we could save it for 2017. Please indicate on your check (if you are paying by check) that the donation is for the "Adopt a Singer" program.

Tammy and I are going to "get the ball rolling" by adopting a singer for the full four- month period, (September through December) so now we are looking at raising only \$2200. I hope that you will prayerfully consider helping our choir achieve this goal so that it can continue to be a viable and important part of the ministry here at St. John's! Blessings! Ken Breeden

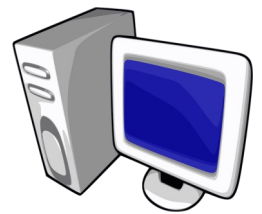

100 years ago

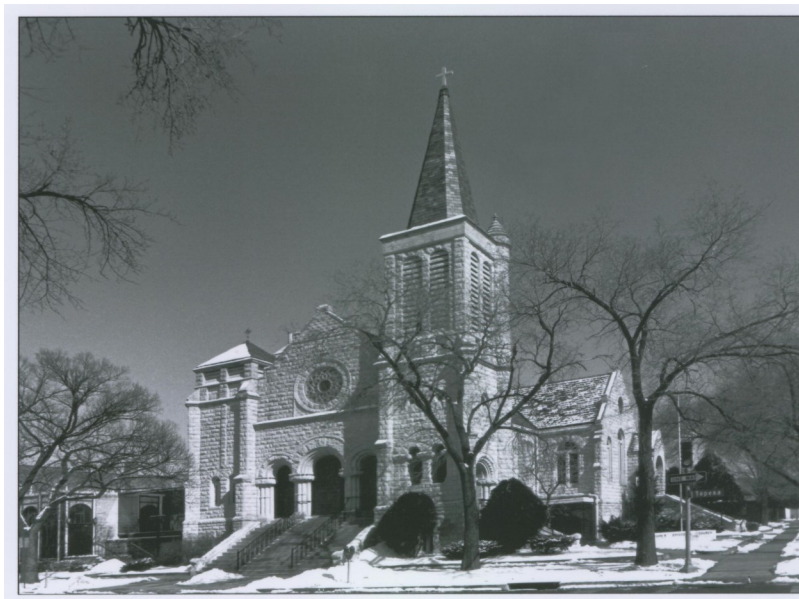
More instructions from the Rev. Percy T. Fenn's 1916 Hand-Book of St. John's Parish:

FOR THOSE WHO ARE SICK

Your priest is always ready, at any hour of the day or night, to minister to the sick of the parish. But it is the duty of the sick to send him word. The rubric at the top of the Order for the visitation of the sick, reads as follows: "When any person is sick, notice SHALL be given thereof to the Minister of the Parish." ~ It is most gratifying to see the increasingly large number of our people who do desire the ministrations of their rector, prayers and the sacraments of the Church, and these are to be had for the asking, and upon these, to a very large extent, our recovery may depend. ~ In case it should be necessary to go to the hospital, please give orders to your physician for your priest to visit you. Your priest does not come to you as a visitor, so "Visitors are not admitted" does not apply to him. He comes to you as your priest, with the Church's blessing, and with the Church's Sacraments. ~ It would, therefore, be well for every sick person, before going to the hospital, to consult the priest in regard to this matter, and to employ only such physicians and surgeons as shall be willing to have your priest come to you. ~ We insist, most earnestly, upon this, for your sake as well as for ours. In a matter of life or death you cannot afford to exclude God. And no good churchman ever goes through an operation without the sacraments, and the prayers of the Church!

CHURCH PAPERS

A church paper should be in the home of every family in the parish. The best paper published is "The Living Church." It is published weekly in Milwaukee. Its tone is Catholic, and it is uncompromising. And this is what we need. We shall never know what the Church is doing everywhere, and how she is laying hold of the masses unless we subscribe for a Church paper. The Living Church is worth its weight in gold, and is indispensable to all those who desire to keep pace with the progress of the Church. The Churchman is the organ of the Broad Churchmen, who water down the teaching of the Church, and should be eschewed. ~ And we are glad to know that our Diocesan paper — The Kansas Churchman — is having a larger circulation in the parish. It is ably edited, and worth a good deal more than it costs. But its news is only Diocesan, and we need a weekly paper.

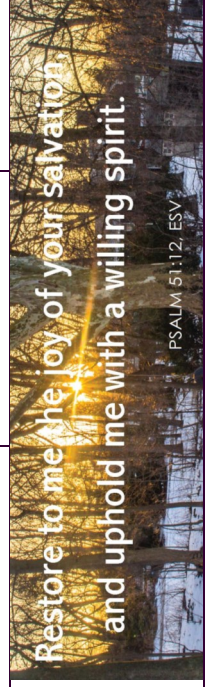
